Т	Title	Look at the title. What do you think the poem will be about?	Literally, what do you think it's about?
P	Paraphrase	Put each stanza into your own words.	Do not miss details!
D	Devices	Examine the poem for deeper meaning by analyzing poetic, literary, and/or rhetorical devices.	For example: Figurative Language Imagery Syntax Symbolism Diction
A	Attitude	What is the tone?	There may be more than one tone going on!
S	Shifts	Look for changes in tone, topic, and/or speaker. What do the shifts mean to the poem?	Key indicators: - Transitional words like but, yet, although, etc Stanza divisions - Changes in line or stanza length - Use of dialogue or changing point of view - Sharp contrasts in diction - Punctuation
Т	Title	Look at the title again. Does it have new meaning?	Figuratively, what is the poem about?
Т	Theme	What is the overall meaning of the poem? What message or idea(s) is the poet expressing?	Themes are abstract ideas and are always a sentence, not single words.
